ASPERGER SYNDROME

Our speaker is Ron Hedgcock who has been diagnosed with Asperger Syndrome. He is the author of 'CONFESSIONS OF AN UNASHAMED ASPERGER' which was published in 2009.

Ron has worked, as an actor, in Radio, Stage and TV and is currently a tutor at U3A Geelong in Art History and Singers of renown. He has presented public lectures for Autism Victoria.

Asperger Syndrome, which is variation of Autism, is not any type of pathology that can be 'caught'. There are many children and adults, some of whom you may know, that have been diagnosed with the Syndrome. Come and be informed by Ron as he explains the unique difficulties and hiccups that life on the spectrum provides, along with the inevitable difficulties that relatives and associates have in dealing with people with the Syndrome.
